■ **FELLOWSHIP DESCRIPTION**

The Davis Center for Russian Studies conducts an annual competition for grants to defray the cost of research travel to the former Soviet Union or Eastern Europe. Students who are not eligible for FLAS summer language fellowships (i.e., non-US citizens or permanent residents) may apply for a travel grant to support formal language study in one of these countries. The maximum stipend is generally \$4,000 and can be used during the summer of 2008 or during the 2008-09 academic year for a minimum stay of six weeks.

■ **ELIGIBILITY**

The competition is open to Harvard doctoral students in the humanities or social sciences, as well as to first-year master's degree candidates in the Program in Regional Studies: Russia, Eastern Europe, and Central Asia.

■ **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Please submit to the Davis Center the completed application form and ONE set of supporting materials, assembled in the order specified in the checklist accompanying the standard application.

DO NOT STAPLE any application materials; paper clips and binder clips may be used, if desired.

NB: The Davis Center requires only ONE letter of recommendation.

The transcript and letter of recommendation may either be mailed directly to the Davis Center or left in their original sealed envelopes and turned in with the application.

All application materials, including the transcript and letter of recommendation, must be received by the Davis Center at the address below by the application deadline of **Friday, February 29, 2008**.
